Lack information about the previous study findings for readers to follow the present study rationale and procedures. The methods are not appropriate. The results are not clear enough. Statistical analysis is not presented and there is no interpretation.

The authors should consider in several points below:

1. Title is unclear.

2. The author should describe the novelty and urgency of study.

3. Describe the method detail, material including the brand etc.

4. The reference of method should be included.

5. Discussion section should describe the parameter to categorize the level activity of substance.

6. Describe the Information of compounds from the previous study in this plants in the discussion section.

7. Conclusions mention " The dose of 500 mg/kg weight gave the best decrease in body temperature of mice but did not differ significantly from ibuprofen", does this dose promising for develop Maja as drug development for antipyretic?

8. English proofread is necessary to improve the quality of paper
